VISION





Key Action 2: Cooperation among Organisations and Institutions

Priorities:

- Four horizontal priorities
- Sector-specific priorities

Projects must address one or more priorities (horizontal ili sector-specifc)

Budget

Cooperation Partnerships: 100.000,00 – 400.000,00 EUR Small-scale Partnerships: 30.000,00 EUR or 60.000,00 EUR

Duration

Cooperation Partnerships: 12 – 36 months Small-scale Partnerships: 6 – 24 months

Partners organisations

Cooperation Partnerships: min. 3 from 3 different programme countries Small-scale Partnerships: min. 2 from 2 different programme countries







Key Action 2: Cooperation Partnerships

Enable **transition and positive change** at individual, organisational and sectoral level

Emphasise **common needs and priorities** in the field of VET

Develop capacities of participating organisations through international and intersectoral cooperation

Ensure **quality increase and relevance of activities** implemented by participating organisations





Key Action 2: Cooperation Partnerships

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Eligibility rules similar to former Strategic Partnership

Virtual MEs


Organisations from partner countries: rejection concept modification
